RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Section 15-316(c) of the Illinois Vehicle Code (Illinois Revised Statutes, Chapter 95-1/2, Article 15-316(c) states as follows:

(c) Local authorities with respect to highways, under their jurisdiction may also, by ordinance or resolution, prohibit the operation of trucks or other commercial vehicles, or may impose limitations as the weight thereof, on designated highways, which prohibitions and limitations shall be designated by appropriate signs placed on such highways,

and;

WHEREAS, to prevent undue damage to County Highway No. 57, further described as follows: Except for that portion off the North end in the city limits of Shipman, Illinois, the road begins at Illinois Route 16 near the North Quarter Corner of Section 25, Township 8 North, Range 9 West of the Third Principal Meridian, Macoupin County, Illinois, and runs directly South approximately 4-1/2 miles to County Highway No. 14 near the center of Section 13, Township 7 North, Range 9 West of the Third Principal Meridian, Macoupin County, Illinois;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY BOARD OF MACOUPIN COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1:- That a weight limitation in the maximum amount of 12 tons (24,000 pounds) be and it is hereby established for said County Highway No. 57 as hereinabove described; and it is unlawful for any person to operate any truck, trailer, machinery, equipment or any motor vehicle having a total weight in excess of 12 tons (24,000 pounds), including any cargo thereon, along or upon said Highway No. 57 at any time.

Section 2:- That the County Highway Department of Macoupin County, Illinois, is hereby directed to erect or cause to be erected appropriate signs designating said weight limitation at each end of said Highway No. 57, and in such other places along said highway as deemed appropriate by said Highway Department; and this Resolution shall be effective when said signs are placed along and upon said road by the County Highway Department.

Section 3:- Every person convicted of a violation of this Resolution shall be subject to the penalties as prescribed in the Illinois Vehicle Code for violations of Article 15 of said Code.
