As you are all well aware of the financial impact the closure of both the Monterey and Crown II mines have had on Macoupin County government, we are writing to ask for your support.

Senator Demuzio has filed SB 2445 that would allow for counties with active coal mines to retain a greater portion of the sales tax generated from the sale of coal to be used for local economic development projects. While this bill is in a draft phase, we feel, this concept would give us a valuable, yet modest, funding stream to enhance our local and regional economic development efforts.
