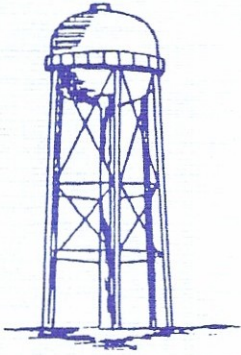




The petitioners respectfully state that:



- (6) The reappointment of J. Richard Johnson is hereby recommended to fill said vacancy.


Wherefore, action by the County Board of Macoupin County, Illinois is hereby respectfully requested to fill the aforesaid vacancy.


