WHEREAS, the provision of public transit service is essential to the transportation of persons in the non-urbanized area; and

WHEREAS, Section 5311(i) of the Federal Transit Act of 1991, as amended (49 U.S.C. § 5311), makes funds available to help offset certain operating deficits and administrative expenses of a system providing public transit service in non-urbanized areas; and

WHEREAS, grants for said funds will impose certain obligations upon the recipient, including the provision by it of the local share of funds necessary to cover costs not covered by funds provided under Section 5311(i) of the Federal Transit Act of 1991, as amended (49 U.S.C. § 5311).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THE MACOUPIN COUNTY

Section 1. That an application be made to the Division of Public and Intermodal Transportation, Department of Transportation, State of Illinois, for a financial assistance grant under Section 5311(i) of the Federal Transit Act of 1991, as amended (49 U.S.C. § 5311), for the purpose of off-setting a portion of the Public Transportation Program operating deficits of the MACOUPIN COUNTY.

Section 2. That while participating in said operating assistance program the MACOUPIN COUNTY PUBLIC HEALTH DEPARTMENT will provide all required local matching funds.

WHEREAS, the Animal Control Committee of the County Board recommends updating the fee and penalty structure in accordance with changes requested by the Department in order to charge and impose acceptable increases over those adopted in 2009 by the Board; therefore

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Macoupin County Board that the following fee and penalty schedule presented by the Macoupin County Resolution 2009.29 is hereby amended as follows:
