
RE: CDAP Public Facility Construction and Design Engineering Grant Applications

The West Central Development Council, Inc., located in Carlinville, Illinois would like to take this opportunity to inform you that we are available to assist your community in writing grants. The WCDC provides its services free of charge for the preparation and submittal of Construction and/or Design Engineering Grant Applications for the purpose of improving and/or replacing water/sewer systems. Construction grants have a \$400,000.00 grant ceiling and must be leveraged with at least 25% of community funds. Design Engineering grant applications have a \$100,000.00 grant ceiling with no matching money required.


Please keep in mind that there is a three (3) month lead time in the preparation of a grant because of the federal requirements that have to be met most noticeably the income survey of the project area, a public hearing and the hiring of an engineer to prepare the cost estimates.

The West Central Development Council (WCDC) is an advisory and administrative organization serving units of local government in Calhoun, Christian, Jersey, Greene, Macoupin, Montgomery, Morgan, Scott, and Shelby Counties.



The WCDC is managed by a governing Board of Directors comprised of representatives from the nine county region. Professional and support staff headed by the Executive Director, Michael Sherer (217-854-9642 ext. 235) carry out the day-to-day operations of the agency. The WCDC advises and cooperates with units of local government to assist them in making decisions regarding current and future development activities. The areas of assistance encompass economic development, community development and workforce development. The WCDC offers a variety of technical and professional services to governmental units in the region.

Since the WCDC operates on a not-for-profit basis, these services are provided either free or at a low-cost through contractual arrangements.

The WCDC Community Development Department is available to assist member counties, cities, villages, towns/townships identify potential funding sources, interpret administrative requirements, provide guidance and technical assistance with regard to submission of applications. Michael Cavanaugh (217-854-9644 ext. 225) and the WCDC staff regularly furnishes the region with grant preparation and administration services.

The agency works closely with numerous Federal/State/County/Community Economic Development Agencies/Departments to ensure our nine county region continues to grow and prosper in a planned and organized manner.

The WCDC provides assistance to the region with Community Development Assistance Applications, Flood Mitigation Grant preparation, Rural Development Planning, and energy Efficiency and conservation Block Grant Program (EEDBG), and is designated

Economic Development Region federally funded by the U.S. Economic Development Administration.

Economic stability and community growth for our member counties and their communities is dependent on a skilled and educated workforce.

The West Central Development Council workforce development services are provided in the local One-Stop Centers ... in our local workforce area these offices are known as local Job Centers.

Full-service Job Centers are located in Carlinville, Litchfield, and Jacksonville. The WCDC also operates two satellite centers which are located in Jerseyville and Shelbyville.

Job Centers are a culmination of state and local agencies partnering their services to make it convenient for the job seeker and local businesses to obtain a wide range of services at one location.
